POINTS OF INTEREST

Blessed Yaacub the Capuchin—26 June

Blessed Yaacub the Capuchin was born on 1 February 1875 in Ghazir, Lebanon. His father, Boutros, and his mother, Shams, were very pious parents.

In 1920 he founded the “Franciscan Sisters of the Cross of Lebanon” who help the sick and the poor.

In 1951, on the 50th Anniversary of his Ordination to the Priesthood, Abouna Yaacub transformed the Convent of the Cross, from an asylum, to a hospital for mental and psychological diseases. He was awarded the Lebanese Cedars’ Medal, an official recognition from the Lebanese Government. The movement of charity begun at Jall Eddib spread throughout Lebanon. Abouna Yaacub and the nuns multiplied their works of social assistance throughout Lebanon. Abouna Yaacub passed away on 26 June 1954.

On 23 June 2008, Abouna Yacuub was beatified. Tens of thousands of people gathered in Martyr’s Square in Beirut to witness his beatification. May his prayers be with us.
