POINTS OF INTEREST

The 350 Martyrs, Disciples of St. Maron—31 July

These disciples were monks living in different monasteries in northern Syria, adjacent to northern Lebanon. They held strongly to the Catholic belief of the teaching of the Fourth Ecumenical Council of Chalcedon in 451, which stated that Christ had two natures: divine and human.

Patriarch Severus, who had embraced the non-Chalcedonian doctrines, persecuted the monks and had 350 of them killed in the year 517. Their brethren who were left behind presented Pope Hormisdas (514-523) an affidavit stating how their brothers were martyred and how Patriarch Severus had persecuted them.

The pope answered them in 518 with a letter in which he offered his sympathy and urged them to stay steadfast against the persecution. The Maronite Church remembers them as her Forefathers. May their prayers be with us.
