## POINTS OF INTEREST

### All Saints Day—1 November

The Church consecrates each day of the year for the remembrance of a saint. But many saints were not added to the list. Thus, there came to be instituted the feast of All Saints, which is celebrated as the feast of the glorious and triumphant Church. This feast, celebrated in the Church, dates back to the year 609, when Pope Boniface IV consecrated the Pantheon in Rome to the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the martyrs. The Feast of All Saints, on its current date, is traced to the foundation of Pope Gregory III (731-741) of an oratory in St. Peter's for the relics of All Saints.

In 837, Pope Gregory IV visited France and upon his insistence, King Louis the Pious issued a decree making All Saints Day a holy day of obligation throughout the Frankish Empire. The Maronite Church follows the Roman Church in this celebrations. May the prayers of all the saints be with us.
