POINTS OF INTEREST

St. Sharbel— 23 July

St. Sharbel was born May 8 in Biqa-Kafra, North Lebanon in the year 1828. He entered the Lebanese Maronite Order and for sixteen years he lived in St. Maron Monastery at Annaya. St. Sharbel completely stripped himself of the outside world. He abandoned any human aspirations. Eventually, he chose to live the life of a hermit and moved to the hermitage of St. Paul on the hill near the monastery. He spent twenty-five years in solitude and prayers until his death in 1898. His body, after his death, continuously bled and perspired. Numerous miracles have been attributed to St. Sharbel. He was beatified at the end of the Second Vatican Council on December 5, 1965 and canonized on October 9, 1977. The tomb and the hermitage of St. Sharbel remain a focal point of veneration of this great saint. Thousands of pilgrims, from near and far, come to glorify God through his saints at the place where St. Sharbel lived, walked, and prayed. May his prayers be with us.
