POINTS OF INTEREST

St. Luke the Evangelist — 18 October

St. Luke was born in Antioch of a pagan family. He was a physician as indicated in St. Paul's epistle to the Colossians. He had become a disciple of the Apostle Paul. He later followed St. Paul until the Apostle's martyrdom in Rome. St. Luke's Gospel was written in Greek. There we find the account describing the infancy of Jesus taken directly from the lips of the Virgin Mary. St. Luke is also the author of the Acts of the Apostles. It is believed that he died at the age of 84 in the year 90. May his prayers be with us.
