



The 350 Martyrs, Disciples of Saint Maron. These disciples of Saint Maron were monks living in different monasteries in northern Syria. They held strongly to the teachings of the Fourth Ecumenical Council of Chalcedon in 451, which stated that Christ had two natures: Divine and human. Sadly, because of divisions in the Church, these monks were persecuted and martyred in the year 517 for adhering to the beliefs of the Fourth Ecumenical Council of Chalcedon. The Maronite Church remembers them as her forefathers in the faith. May their prayers be with us.
