The palms that will be blessed, distributed, and decorate the sanctuary for Hosanna Sunday and the Easter Flowers that will decorate the Sanctuary for the Sunday and Season of the Glorious Resurrection are donated by George Nehme, in loving memory of his parents and sister and, they are also donated in loving memory of the Raya and Hashim Families by Lou Raya and family.

**Passion Week.** Please consult the **Passion Week Liturgical Schedule** for a complete listing of Passion Week Liturgies. Please make every effort to attend these most important liturgies and join us in prayer throughout this most holy week.

Wednesday of Passion Week. This Wednesday of Passion Week, 5 April, at 6:30pm we will celebrate the Rite of the Lamp, the Blessing of Oil, and Anointing, especially for the sick.

**Thursday of Mysteries.** This Thursday of Mysteries, **6 April,** at **6:30pm** we will celebrate the Divine Liturgy and the Washing of Feet immediately followed by a brief period of Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Great Friday. This Great Friday of the Crucifixion, 7 April, we will celebrate the Signing of the Chalice at 9AM and the Adoration of the Cross at 6:30PM. Please remember to bring fresh cut flowers to place in the shroud before the Adoration of the Cross. The collection at both services will be for the Christians in the Holy Land who need our support.

**Great Saturday**. This Great Saturday of the Light, **8 April**, at **11AM** we will celebrate the **Service of Forgiveness** and **individual confessions**.

Fish Fry. Our final Lenten Fish Fry and the Great Friday Dinner will be this Friday, 7 April, from 4-7PM in the George Sfeir Parish Hall, Dine-In or Take-Out. \$15 for adults and \$6 for children (10 and under). Lentils and Rice (*Mjadra*) will be available. If you would like to donate baked goods, please contact Mary Ann at 315-790-3307. At the same time, the Maronite Youth Organization (MYO) will continue their fundraising sale to support their attendance at their national conference. They are our sons and daughters, please support them.

Abstinence and Fasting. All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat and fast on this Friday, Great Friday of the Crucifixion, 7 April. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on this day.

**Saint Mary's Guild.** The Saint Mary's Guild will have their annual **Communion Breakfast** on **Sunday, 21 May**, immediately following the 10am Divine Liturgy at Monarch Banquets.
