



Ascension Thursday. Forty days after His Resurrection, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, ascended into Heaven. This year, the Church celebrates the Ascension of Our Lord on Thursday, 18 May. Because of the importance of this feast, we will celebrate the **Divine Liturgy** on **Thursday, 18 May** at **9AM** and **6:30PM**. Please make every effort to attend.

Month of May. During the month of May, the Church honors the Blessed Virgin Mary and encourages the faithful to pray the Rosary. Please try to pray the Rosary throughout this month. Each year, on the first Sunday of May, the Maronite Church honors the Blessed Virgin Mary, as Our Lady of Lebanon.

Second Collection. Next weekend, **6-7 May**, the feast of Our Lady of Lebanon, the **second collection** will be for the National **Shrine of Our Lady of Lebanon** in North Jackson (Youngstown), Ohio. Thank you in advance for your continued generosity.
