



# **POINTS OF INTEREST**

Saint Anthony of Padua. On 13 June the Church celebrates Saint Anthony of Padua. He was born in Lisbon, Portugal on 15 August 1195. He was ordained a priest in 1222. He became one of the first followers of Saint Francis of Assisi. He lived a holy life and was noted for his preaching, teaching, and writing. He spent the last years of his life in the city of Padua, Italy. He died at thirty-six years of age on 13 June 1231. He was canonized one year after his death by Pope Gregory IX. Devotion to Saint Anthony of Padua was brought to Lebanon by the Franciscan Missionaries in the fifteenth century. May his prayers be with us.
