



Congratulations. We offer our prayerful congratulations to Joseph Joshua Nelson, the son of Alyssa (Lewis) and Joshua Nelson, who was baptized and chrismated on 10 June. May God bless him as he begins his journey of faith.

Saint Louis Gonzaga. This Wednesday, 21 June we celebrate the feast of our patron, Saint Louis (Aloysius) Gonzaga, at the 9AM Divine Liturgy. Please join us in prayer. We will pray at the grave of Father Louis Lotaif in Calvary Cemetery. We wish a blessed feast day to all, especially those named in honor of Saint Louis Gonzaga.

Saint Louis was born on 9 March 1568 in northern Italy, the eldest of eight children born to the noble Gonzaga family. As the oldest son he was to inherit his father's noble title and serve in the military. However, Louis had a strong calling to a religious life. On 25 November 1585, at seventeen years old, against the wishes of his father, he entered the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). Louis began his studies in Milan, Italy to become a priest of the Society of Jesus. In 1591 when a plague struck Rome, Italy, the Jesuits opened a hospital to care for the victims. Louis willingly worked in the hospital caring for the people dying from plague. He contracted the plague himself and died on 21 June 1591 at twenty three years old. He was canonized in 1726. May his prayers be with us.

Our first pastor, Father Louis Lotaif named our parish in honor of his own patron, Saint Louis Gonzaga.
