





POINTS OF INTEREST

Blessed Yacoub Haddad the Capuchin. One 26 June the Maronite Church celebrates Blessed Yacoub Haddad the Capuchin. His religious name, Yacoub, translates to James or Jacques. He is known for being a member of the Capuchin Franciscan Friars. He was born on 1 February 1875 in Ghazir, Lebanon. In 1893 he entered the Capuchin Franciscans and on 1 November 1901 he was ordained a priest in Beirut, Lebanon. From 1903 to 1914 he walked all over Lebanon proclaiming the Word of God and was given the name, "the Apostle of Lebanon." Abouna Yacoub, as he was known in life, helped anyone in need, especially the poor and the sick. In 1920, to assist him, he founded the Franciscan Sisters of the Holy Cross of Lebanon. Together they opened hospitals, orphanages, schools, and homes for the care of the chronically ill and the homeless. During his life he received numerous honors from the Presidents of Lebanon for his charitable works. He died on 26 June 1954. He was beatified on 22 June 2008. May his prayers be with us.

Assumption Pilgrimage. The Annual Assumption Pilgrimage to the National Shrine of Our Lady of Lebanon in North Jackson, Ohio will be from Monday through Wednesday, 14-16 August. There will be an evening Liturgy and outdoor procession on Monday 14 August. On Tuesday 15 August the Church celebrates the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven.
