



The Sunday of the Finding of our Lord in the Temple. This Sunday the Maronite Church celebrates the Finding of Our Lord in the Temple. The Divine Liturgy will follow regular weekend schedule, Saturday 30 December at 4PM and on Sunday 31 December at 10AM.
