Stations and Benediction of the Cross. On the **Fridays** of **Great Lent** through **22 March** at **6:30PM** we will celebrate the Stations and Benediction of the Cross in the **Church**. Please make every effort to attend these important Lenten prayers.

Abstinence and Fasting. All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Great Lent. Ash Monday and Great Friday of the Crucifixion (29 March) are also days of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on these two days.
