#### POINTS OF INTEREST

**Liturgical Calendar.** This week the Maronite Church celebrates **Hosanna Week**, in preparation for Hosanna (Palm) Sunday. In the Maronite Church, Friday of this week is the Fortieth Day of Great Lent when we commemorate the **Temptation** of **Jesus** in the **Wilderness**. On Saturday of this week the Maronite Church commemorates the **Raising** of **Lazarus**. Please join us in prayer as we prepare for Passion Week.

Saint Joseph. On 19 March the Church celebrates the feast of Saint Joseph. We wish a blessed feast day to all those named in honor of Saint Joseph and all those who have special devotion to him. May his prayers be with us all.

Saint Joseph was the chaste spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was a carpenter from Nazareth and a descendant of King David. He brought Mary to Bethlehem where Jesus was born and to the Temple in Jerusalem forty days later. Joseph led the Holy Family to safety in Egypt during the persecution of King Herod. He also brought them safely back to Nazareth where they lived and worked. He led Mary and Jesus to and from the Temple in Jerusalem for the Passover when Jesus was twelve years old and temporarily remained behind, teaching in the Temple. This is the last time Joseph is mentioned in Sacred Scripture. Because Jesus entrusted His mother to Saint John upon the cross, it can be inferred that Joseph had died by the time Jesus began his public ministry.

Saint Joseph Society Bake Sale. The Saint Joseph Society will hold their Annual Bake Sale this Saturday,16 March and this Sunday, 17 March in the George Sfeir Parish Hall before and after the Divine Liturgies. They will also be collecting annual dues. Please support them.

Stations and Benediction of the Cross. On the Fridays of Great Lent through 22 March at 6:30pm we will celebrate the Stations and Benediction of the Cross in the Church. Please make every effort to attend these important Lenten prayers.

Fish Fry. Our Annual Lenten Fish Fry continues on the Fridays of Great Lent through 29 March from 4-7pm in the George Sfeir Parish Hall, Dine-In or Take-Out. \$15 for adults and \$6 for children under 10. Passion Week. Please consult the Passion Week Liturgical Schedule for a complete listing of Passion Week Liturgies. Please make every effort to attend these most important liturgies and to join us in prayer throughout this most holy week.

Wednesday of Passion Week. On Wednesday of Passion Week, 27 March, at 6:30pm we will celebrate the Rite of the Lamp, the Blessing of Oil, and Anointing.

**Thursday of Mysteries.** On the Thursday of the Mysteries, **28 March**, at **6:30pm** we will celebrate the Divine Liturgy and the Washing of Feet immediately followed by a brief period of Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Great Friday. On Great Friday of the Crucifixion, 29 March, we will celebrate the Signing of the Chalice at 9AM and the Adoration of the Cross at 6:30pm. Please remember to bring fresh cut flowers to place in the shroud before the Adoration of the Cross. The collection at both services will be for the Christians in the Holy Land who need our support.

**Great Saturday**. On Great Saturday of the Light, **30 March**, at **11AM** we will celebrate the **Service of Forgiveness** and individual confessions.
