Christ is Risen! Truly, He is Risen!

Blessed Easter. Father Boutros, Deacon Paul, and Deacon Peter wish you and your families a blessed Easter Sunday and a blessed Easter Season. May the peace and joy of the Risen Christ be with you always.

Season of the Glorious Resurrection. The Sunday of the Glorious Resurrection begins the Season of the Glorious Resurrection. The Season of the Glorious Resurrection lasts seven weeks, a week of weeks, fifty days, until the descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Sunday. The first week of the Season of the Glorious Resurrection is known as White Week. The Second Sunday of the Resurrection is known as New Sunday. It is the first Sunday after the Sunday of the Glorious Resurrection.

Easter Flowers. The Easter Flowers that decorate the Sanctuary for the Sunday and Season of the Glorious Resurrection are donated by Lou Raya and Patty Karam and Sons in remembrance of their parents Mary and Jimmy Raya and the deceased members of the Raya and Hashim Families.

Easter Sunday Hospitality. Immediately following the 10am Divine Liturgy on Easter Sunday, 31 March, there will hospitality in the George Sfeir Parish Hall (eggs, cookies, and coffee) and an Easter Egg Hunt for the children. Please join us and bring your own basket to collect eggs.

Patriarch Estephan Douaihy. On 14 March, His Holiness, Pope Francis, recognized the miracle attributed to the he intercession of the Venerable Servant of God, Patriarch Estephan El Douaihy. Therefore, he will be declared Blessed on 2 August. Beatification is the final step on the journey to sainthood. He was born in Ehden, Lebanon on 2 August 1630. On 20 May 1670 he was elected the fifty-seventh Patriarch of Antioch for the Maronites. He served as patriarch for thirty-four years until his death on 3 May 1704 in Qannoubine, Lebanon, in the Holy (Qadisha) Valley. He was a leader and a writer, having researched and written on the history of the Maronite Church. He was also a reformer of the Maronite Church, including her monastic orders and liturgy. May his prayers be with us.
