Respect Life Month. The Catholic Church in the United States has designated **October** as **Respect Life Month**. During this month, please take some time to pray for and work for **respect** for **all human life** from natural conception to natural death.

Massabki Martyrs Canonization. On 20 October at the Vatican, His Holiness, Pope Francis elevated the three Maronite Massabki brothers, Francis, Abdel Mooti, and Raphael, to saints. They were three of the six children born to the Maronite Massabki family in Damascus, Syria in the early 1800s. They were laymen who were among the thousands of Christians who shed their blood for Christ in the persecutions of 1860 and 1861 in Lebanon and Syria. On the night of 9 July 1860, they fled to the Franciscan Church in Damascus for safety, but their assailants were able to enter the Church and demanded that the brothers abandon their Catholic Christian faith in Jesus Christ. In the name of the three brothers, Francis refused their demand. The three Massabkis were martyred that night in the Franciscan Church of Damascus. Their bodies were buried in the Maronite Church in Damascus. May their prayers be with us.

The Maronite Church honors Saint Sharbel on the 22nd day of every month in honor of the healing of Nohad El-Shami on 22 January 1993 when Saint Sharbel operated on her in her sleep, healing her paralysis. Therefore, this Tuesday, 22 October at 6PM we will celebrate the Divine Liturgy in honor of Saint Sharbel for the healing of all who are sick with the blessing with a relic of Saint Sharbel and anointing with oil.
