



Liturgical Year. This Sunday, the last Sunday of October, is the last Sunday of the Maronite Liturgical Year, the Sunday of Christ the King. Next Sunday, the first Sunday of November, the Maronite Church begins a new Liturgical Year. The Maronite Liturgical Year begins with the Sundays of the Church, followed by the six Sundays of Joyful Announcements to prepare for the Glorious Birth of Our Lord on 25 December.
