From Saturday, 18 January, the Establishment of the Chair of Saint Peter in Rome, until 25 January, the Conversion of Saint Paul the Apostle, Christians observe the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Saint Marianne Cope. On 23 January the Church in the United States honors Saint Marianne Cope. Saint Marianne was born on 23 January 1838 in Germany. The following year she immigrated to Utica, New York with her family. They resided on Schuyler Street and attended what was then Saint Joseph's Church on Columbia Street. In 1862 she entered the Sisters of Saint Francis in Syracuse. She founded Saint Elizabeth Hospital in Utica in 1866 and Saint Joseph's Hospital in Syracuse in 1869. In 1883 she went to Hawaii to care for the lepers and remained there until her death in 1918. She was beatified in 2005 and canonized in 2012. May her prayers be with us.
