



Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. From Saturday, 18 January, the Establishment of the Chair of Saint Peter in Rome, until 25 January, the Conversion of Saint Paul the Apostle, Christians observe the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. Please join in prayer throughout this time for Christian unity.

22 January. This Wednesday, 22 January, the Catholic Church in the United States observes a day of **prayer** for the **legal protection** of **unborn** children. Please join the Catholic Church throughout the United States in prayer on this day for the legal protection of unborn children. On Saturday, 18 January, there was a local Mass, Holy Hour, and March for Life at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Syracuse. This Friday, 24 January, is the National March for Life in Washington, D.C.

Saint Marianne Cope. On 23 January the Church in the United States honors Saint Marianne Cope. Saint Marianne was born on 23 January 1838 in Germany. The following year she immigrated to Utica, New York with her family. They resided on Schuyler Street and attended what was then Saint Joseph's Church on Columbia Street. In 1862 she entered the Sisters of Saint Francis in Syracuse. She founded Saint Elizabeth Hospital in Utica in 1866 and Saint Joseph's Hospital in Syracuse in 1869. In 1883 she went to Hawaii to care for the lepers and remained there until her death in 1918. She was beatified in 2005 and canonized in 2012. May her prayers be with us.
