### **POINTS OF INTEREST**

Forty Martyrs. On 9 March the Church celebrated the Forty Martyrs of Sebaste (in present day Turkey). Around the year 322, the governor of Sebaste wished to force forty soldiers to renounce Christ. First, he imprisoned them. Then, he threw them into a frozen pond. They prayed with one heart: "We forty have entered the arena, O Lord, grant that we may be able to receive the crown [of martyrdom]." One of them escaped and renounced Christ, but their guard, a pagan, inspired by the faith of the thirty-nine others who remained, took his place. In the morning the guards broke their legs an burned their bodied. May their prayers be with us. (Adapted from the Maronite Synaxarion)

Saint Joseph. On 19 March the Church celebrates Saint Joseph, the spouse of Mary. Therefore, to honor Saint Joseph, on this Wednesday, 19 March, the 9AM Divine Liturgy will be celebrated in Church with the novena prayers in honor of Saint Joseph. Please join us in prayer. We wish a blessed feast day to all those named in honor of Saint Joseph and all those who have special devotion to him. May his prayers be with us all.

Saint Joseph was the chaste spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was a carpenter from Nazareth and a descendant of King David. He brought Mary to Bethlehem where Jesus was born and to the Temple in Jerusalem forty days later. Joseph led the Holy Family to safety in Egypt during the persecution of King Herod. He also brought them safely back to Nazareth where they lived and worked. He led Mary and Jesus to and from the Temple in Jerusalem for the Passover when Jesus was twelve years old and temporarily remained behind, teaching in the Temple. This is the last time Joseph is mentioned in Sacred Scripture. Because Jesus entrusted His mother to Saint John upon the cross, it can be inferred that Joseph had died by the time Jesus began his public ministry.
