Passion Week. Please make every effort throughout this most holy week to attend these most important liturgies and to join us in prayer.

Abstinence and Fasting. All Maronites who are physically capable are to abstain from meat on all Fridays of Great Lent. Great Friday of the Crucifixion (18 April) is also a day of fasting. Fasting in the Maronite Church involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken, but without meat. All Maronites who are physically capable are to fast on this day.

Divine Liturgy Intentions. There are weekday and weekend Divine Liturgies that can be offered for your intentions. To schedule a Divine Liturgy in honor or memory of a loved one, please contact the parish house during office hours.

Memorials. Memorials for the offerings regularly used in the Sanctuary as part of the Divine Liturgy can be offered for your intentions. The Bread and Wine, the Candles, and the Plants and Flowers are available for a week, a month, or the year for a donation of \$10 per week to memorialize or honor a loved one.
