POINTS OF INTEREST

Saint Katharine Drexel. On 3 March the Church in the United States honored Saint Katharine Drexel. She was born in Philadelphia in 1858, the daughter of Francis A. Drexel, a prominent banker. Katharine gave her fortune and her life to serve the poor and the oppressed, particularly African American and Native American people. She helped finance many missions among them. In 1891, she founded a missionary community, The Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament. The Eucharist was the center of and sustenance for her life; she saw it as the source of unity among races. She died on March 3, 1955 and was canonized in 2000. May her prayers be with us.
