POINTS OF INTEREST

Feast of Saint Louis Gonzaga. On 21 June the Church celebrates Saint Louis Gonzaga. We wish a blessed feast day to all, especially those named in honor of Saint Louis. We will celebrate the feast of our patron saint this Saturday 21 June at the 4PM Divine Liturgy and this Sunday 22 June at the 10AM Divine Liturgy.

Saint Louis was born on 9 March 1568 in northern Italy, the eldest of eight children born to the noble Gonzaga family. As the oldest son he was to inherit his father's noble title and serve in the military. However, Louis had a strong calling to a religious life. On 25 November 1585, at seventeen years old, against the wishes of his father, he entered the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). Louis began his studies in Milan, Italy to become a priest of the Society of Jesus. In 1591 when a plague struck Rome, Italy, the Jesuits opened a hospital to care for the victims. Louis willingly worked in the hospital caring for the people dying from plague. He contracted the plague himself and died on 21 June 1591 at twenty-three years old. He was canonized in 1726. May his prayers be with us.
