POINTS OF INTEREST

Feast of Saints Peter and Paul. On 29 June the Church celebrates the feast of the Apostles, Saints Peter and Paul.

Saint Peter, formerly known as Simon, is the brother of Saint Andrew, also an Apostle. Both were called by Jesus to follow Him while fishing. Saint Peter was with Jesus throughout the most important events of His public ministry and was the leader of the Apostles. He was the first Bishop of Antioch and later the first Bishop of Rome and Pope of the Church. He was martyred for his faith in Christ in Rome, Italy.

Saint Paul, formerly known as Saul, was a devout Jew who persecuted Christians, including Saint Stephen, the first martyr, until the Lord appeared to him on the road to Damascus, where Paul was going to persecute the Christian community. He underwent a profound conversion and became a zealous defender and preacher of the Christian faith. He wrote to and visited many of the early Christian communities around the eastern Mediterranean Sea. He was also martyred for his faith in Christ in Rome, Italy.

May the prayers of Saints Peter and Paul be with us.

We wish Father Boutros (Peter), Deacon Paul, and Deacon Peter, and all those named in honor Saints Peter and Paul a blessed feast day.
