POINTS OF INTEREST

Saint Kateri. On 14 July the Catholic Church in the United States honors Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. She was born in 1656, fifty miles east of Utica, at what is now the Shrine of the North American Martyrs in Auriesville, New York. Her mother was an Algonquin Catholic. Her father was a Mohawk chief. After her parents died of smallpox in 1660, she was taken in by her uncle. He discouraged her attempts to become a Catholic and arranged for her to marry. After pleading with her family, she was baptized by the Jesuit Missionaries in 1676, at what is now the National Shrine of Saint Kateri in Fonda, New York. Because of the intense persecution she faced after her conversion to Catholicism, she fled to the Mission of Saint Francis Xavier, a settlement of Catholic Native Americans, outside of Montreal, Canada, where she made a vow of perpetual virginity and dedicated herself to Christ. She spent her remaining days in prayer at Mass, instructing the children in their Catholic faith, and caring for the elderly. In 1680 just shy of her 24th birthday, she died at the Mission, where her earthly remains are venerated. She was beatified in 1980 by Pope John Paul II and canonized in 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI. She is known as the "Lily of the Mohawks." May her prayers be with us.

Saint Sharbel Liturgy and Anointing. In honor of Saint Sharbel's feast day, this Friday, 18 July at 6PM there will be a Divine Liturgy in honor of Saint Sharbel for the healing of all who are sick. There will be a **blessing with a relic** of Saint Sharbel and **anointing with Holy Oil.** Please join us in prayer as we seek Saint Sharbel's intercession for all who are sick.

Feast of Saint Sharbel. On 20 July this year, the third Sunday of July, the Maronite Church celebrates the feast of Saint Sharbel. Therefore, we will celebrate the Divine Liturgy in honor of Saint Sharbel **next Saturday, 19 July at 4PM and next Sunday, 20 July at 10AM.** Please join us in prayer as we celebrate Saint Sharbel.

Recognition of Graduates. On **Sunday, 20 July at the 10AM** Divine Liturgy we will also recognize the graduates from our parish.
